Puget Sound Energy (PSE) offers, to members of the general public, at no charge, tours of its Wild Horse Wind Facility. In consideration of granting this privilege, which privilege I acknowledge as adequate consideration, I, the undersigned, for myself, my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, do hereby agree to assume sole and complete responsibility for any injury suffered while on the premises of PSE; and, hereby waive in advance any and all claims for any such losses, including any right of subrogation I, my heirs, assigns personal representatives, or my insurers may have against PSE, its officers, directors, parents, subsidiaries affiliates or employees.

I further understand and acknowledge that my presence on the premises of PSE and/or participation in the tour can expose me to dangers from both known and unanticipated risk. Acknowledging that such risks exist, I assume that risk, including the risk of negligent conduct, and I release and discharge PSE, its officers, directors, parents, subsidiaries or affiliates from any and all claims or liability for any injury to my person and/or property that may occur while on the premises of PSE. I further agree and covenant not to sue PSE, its officers, directors, parents, subsidiaries affiliates or employees for any such claims.

In signing this release, I FULLY RECOGNIZE THAT IF I AM HURT AND/OR MY PROPERTY IS DAMAGED WHILE ON THE PREMISES OF PSE, I WILL HAVE NO RIGHT TO MAKE A CLAIM OR FILE A LAWSUIT AGAINST PSE, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, PARENTS, SUBSIDIARIES, AFFILIATES OR EMPLOYEES, WITHOUT REGARD TO THE PERSON OR ENTITY CAUSING THE INJURY OR DAMAGE. I HAVE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE. I KNOW AND UNDERSTAND THAT MY SIGNATURE ON THIS FORM OPERATES AS A COMPLETE RELEASE OF PSE, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, PARENTS, SUBSIDIARIES, AFFILIATES OR EMPLOYEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, INCLUDING ITS OWN NEGLIGENCE. I FREELY AND WILLINGLY CONSENT TO THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE.

Things you need to know:

1. Please reconfirm your scheduled tour one-week prior so any changes or additions can be accommodated. Reconfirm your tour via email through the person who helped you set up your tour or by calling the Puget Sound Energy's Renewable Energy Center.

2. Liability forms must be signed prior to participating in the tour.
3. Wear closed-toed sturdy shoes and long pants.
4. Jackets or coats are recommended. The temperature and wind make the site much cooler than may be expected.
5. Hard hats are required and will be provided for site visitors.
6. A site safety review will be provided by Puget Sound Energy prior to the tour.
7. Visitors with pacemakers are prohibited from entering turbine towers because magnets are present.
8. Cameras are encouraged.
9. If the weather is extremely wet or icy the site tour will be rescheduled; however, a "Picture Tour" in a slideshow format will be offered as an alternative to the "Site Tour."
10. If you are driving your own vehicle in the project area with a Puget Sound Energy escort, please note that the access road speed limit is 20 mph.

1. Travel eastbound on Interstate 90 to Ellensburg, take exit 106.
2. Follow the exit around & across the overpass, straight through the 4-way stop. This road becomes University Way.
3. Travel east on University Way through town. University Way becomes Vantage Highway after passing Dairy Queen and crossing the rise.
4. Follow Vantage Highway for 16.5 miles.
5. Turn left at the Wild Horse main gate, and follow the road 3 miles up to the Wild Horse Renewable Energy Center.

1. Travel westbound on Interstate 90 toward Ellensburg; take the Vantage exit #136 just after crossing the Columbia River.
2. Take a left onto Vantage Highway.
3. Follow Vantage Highway for 10.5 miles.
4. Turn right at the Wild Horse main gate, and follow the road 3 miles up to the Wild Horse Renewable Energy Center.
